## Call for Proposals

We invite submissions for individual, poster, and panel presentations for the 16th Biennial IHPST conference to be held July 3-7, 2022 in Calgary, Alberta, Canada. We encourage faculty, graduate and undergraduate students, and science education professionals to apply.

This conference will explore emerging paradigms, approaches, and methods for integrating history, philosophy, and sociology of science with science education in the 21st century.

Please provide a 500-word proposal (not including references) and a 250-word shortened abstract (which will appear in the conference program), as a Word or Google document. Proposals should include focus of presentation, methodological approach, analysis and conclusions. We highly encourage undergraduate students to submit proposals for poster presentations as we will have an option for virtual presentations.

Acceptance will be based on applicability to the conference theme and on their general interest to the IHPST audience. For panel submissions, provide an abstract for the panel as well as presenter names and abstracts for each individual presentation. Label abstract with your name (e.g. Family\_Given\_IHPST 2022).
